You've heard about it, seen pictures of it and the time has once again come to get ready for it! I'm talking about the Rockland Astronomy Club's Summer Star Party. By far this is the longest and the best family oriented star party around. It goes on for ten days in the most beautiful mountain setting in the northwest corner of Massachusetts. The skies are dark and pristine with the milky way arcing across the entire sky from one horizon to the other. I bet I have your attention now!

To start off with we have the nicest, friendliest people you could meet, a comfortable restful atmosphere, meeting people with similar interests and enjoying casual conversations about everything astronomy.

We operate the star party at a beautiful private campground that is completely equipped with everything a family or individual could need. From a dinning hall offering breakfast and dinner everyday to full facility rest rooms with flush toilets and hot showers, a huge spring fed swimming pool, a front office with a small store, playgrounds, ball fields, hiking & biking trails. The campground offers tree shaded campsites that can accommodate tents, campers & RV's each with access to electric, water & a fire pit.

For those who don't or can't camp out, don't worry! There are nearby hotels and motels 15-20 minutes away. You can sleep at the hotel and join us for all the meals, activities and nightly observing so you won't miss a thing!

Our observing field can easily accommodate 250 telescopes and is equipped with electric and water. It is in a huge open treeless mowed grass field that gives a full 360 degree view of the sky. During the day we offer magnificent views of the Sun and provide a quenching drink of lemonade & at night, coffee and cookies; now what better way to view the stars than with a cup of Joe!

We offer programs for the kids from rocket making and launching, to Astronomical Scavenger Hunts, making your own 3D constellation and more. For the teens we have a game and refreshment tent just for them at night. Adults can do a Scope Tour where everyone uncovers their scope in the daytime and gets a chance to show off their toys, and were conveniently located about 1-1/2 hours from the Stellafane Telescope Convention. Take a cooling dip in the spring fed swimming pool or in a nearby icy cold stream. Visit the many tourist spots very close by. Of course you can also count on a very peaceful and quiet alone time that is soothing and relaxing.

We invite you to join us and have a great time! Stay as long or short as you like; all ten days, a weekend or two, a few days; any combination works. Camp with us or stay at local hotels, dine with us or visit the many fine country restaurants in the area. Flexibility is the name of the game. Customize our star party to fit you vacation.

GENERAL INFORMATION

SSP is held at Shady Pines Campground, a privately owned and operated facility located in Savoy, Massachusetts. Accordingly, SSP attendees, their family members and guests must abide by rules and policies established by the owners. The owners reserve the right to evict anyone for violation thereof. Intentional damage to buildings or equipment, the playground, video games, vehicles, swimming pool, or the camping equipment of other campers will result in immediate eviction.

REFUND POLICY

No refunds will be made for late arrival or premature departure from SSP. If you arrive after the arrival date indicated on your reservation form, you may extend your stay beyond the original departure date, provided the campsite is vacant. No refunds will be made if you fail to attend SSP and you have not called to explain why you can't attend to both Shady Pines Campground (413) 743-2694 and to the Rockland Astronomy Club (845) 446-4336.

• Cancellations & refund (for Rockland Astronomy Club fees) before the date of arrival get a full refund less a \$10.00 processing fee.

• Cancellations & refund (for Shady Pines Campground reservation deposit fees) 14 days prior to arrival get refund less \$25.00 administrative fee.

PET POLICY

- Two (2) dogs/pets per campsite are permitted.
- No pets of any kind are permitted in rental trailers or cabins.
- Pets must be caged or kept on a leash at all times.
- Pets must not be left unattended in the campground when you are sightseeing.
- · You must clean up after your pet!

RULES FOR CHILDREN

• Children under the age of 16 may not be left alone in the campground at any time, unless they are under the direct supervision of another SSP adult attendee.

• All children under the age of 16 must be at their own campsite after 11:00 PM unless they are observing at a telescope with a parent.

- No bicycle riding in the campground after dark (Applies to adults & children).
- Children must wear helmets when riding bicycles.
- Children under the age of 16 are not permitted in the swimming pool unless supervised by an adult.
- No tree climbing is allowed.

OBSERVING FIELD RULES

• No telescope setup in the main observing field after sunset!! If you arrive after 8:00 pm, set up your telescope and equipment before setting up your tent & campsite. All vehicles must be removed from the observing field before dark! No driving allowed after dark!!! No white flashlights allowed, use only red flashlights!! An adult refreshment tent is set up in the observing field which provides coffee and cookies at night and cold lemonade in the afternoon for solar observing.

DOOR PRIZES

• Door prizes are drawn on the first Saturday before the Pizza Party. You do not need to be present to win a prize as long as you have registered in advance for SSP, you are eligible to win.

ROCKET BUILDING & LAUNCHING

• Rocket building kits will be distributed at the Dinning Hall at 10:00 AM on the first Sunday. If your child has a rocket that was built in prior years, please bring it with you. We will continue to provide engines and launching equipment.

KID'S PROGRAMS

• During the ten days of SSP we will offer programs for the younger children. These may include a Scavenger Hunt (with ice cream prizes), 3D constellation models, Planet Walk, Native American Folk-Lore, Build a Plani-sphere and others. Time, adult availability and number of kids will determine these events. Check the schedule to see when they occur.

• A teenager activity and refreshment tent is provided on the observing field for evening activities of games and cookies.

ADULT ACTIVITIES

• Check the schedule for lectures, Stellafane day trip, Pro Am swap table, Venders, Scope Tour of all the telescopes on the observing field & others.

GROUP PHOTO

• Each year we all get together and have an entire attendee group photo. This photo is then posted to the Rockland Astronomy Club's web site where you may download it for your own. The photo is taken on the first Saturday outside the dinning hall right after the Pizza Party.

SPEAKERS & VENDORS

• Speakers are welcome to talk at SSP. Subjects can be astronomical in nature and can include slide show presentations as well as related software discussions. These talks however are unpaid.

• Vendors are welcome to join us at SSP. You can stay the entire 10 days, weekends or any combination of time. Usually the weekends are the largest amount of people. Setup can be in the observing field. A one time \$100.00 vendor fee on top of club registration fees and campsite fees is required.
